 - o Q&A
 - What changes are there going to be in FYE?
 - Two versions of the class, one for freshman and one for transfer students
 - Will environmental lecture series continue?
 - 3 speakers, one each quarter
 - o Kim Stanley Robinson on the life of John Muir
 - o Councilmember David Alvarez about zoning
 - Steve Goldbeck talked about sea levels rising
 - Next year, getting ideas of people to bring
 - Hoping to do it at least once per quarter

- What do you think is Muir's biggest problem and how will you address it?
 - Room selection we just don't have enough housing
 - One thing that will help is the end of the 4 year guarantee
 - Next year, there will probably be less crowding
 - o Juniors and Seniors won't be able to live on campus
 - We need to build more housing where? Which colleges will get it?
 - Talk about taking a parking lot and making Muir/Marshall housing
 - Curriculum most flexible GEs, that's good!
 - Working on students needing 72 Upper Division units
 - o 180 units to graduate
 - Proposal put in to change it to 60 UD units
 - If it passes, then Muir will be the same as everyone else
 - Will effect transfer students a lot
- Who would it affect?
 - It's retroactive and would include everyone
 - It could mean that you don't have to do the extra 72 units
 - UCSD has lowest percentage of freshman who graduate in 4yrs and transfers that graduate in 2yrs
- MOM
 - Some are proposing that MOM should not be run by the college
 - Patty and Provost worked together
 - Plan:
 - o It's doing really well
 - College will pay down \$60k deficit with \$50k
 - Hopefully next year there will be no deficit
 - Could buy a projector and a screen to have movie nights
 - Could get artists to play
 - Can do a lot once it's out of debt
- Units?
 - If you take 12 each quarter you won't graduate in 4 years
 - Maybe having students take 12 units + Freshman seminar = 13 units
 - Need to lower the number of units in a way that doesn't impact students negatively yet still get students out in 4 years
- Do you think there are enough hydration stations ?
 - 2 in the college, one in Roots, and one in Pines

- More would be beneficial
- International Students
 - Aiming for 20% international students
 - More of a policy than a cap
- Lots of pressure coming from president Napolitano who's getting pressure from the state government
 - Various people talking about what changes can be made
 - Some GEs are decreasing in some colleges
 - There are more people eligible for UCs than there is space
 - If you keep people for an extra year, that's another person that can't attend a UC
- Vote coming up on basic writing program (ELWR / SDCC courses)
 - Used to: have to take course and pass the exit exam
 - Revamped the curriculum for SDCC no need for exit exam
 - Proposing that exit exam gets taken away
 - Must be taken to faculty senate for approval
