 - We have to embrace the traditions, create an event that students want to go to, yet make an event the administration is comfortable holding

 - Splitting up into 3 smaller events in RIMAC
 - Cancelling the festival
 - We want Hullabaloo to be AWESOME
 - Few or no incidents
 - Can use that festival as a point of reference to prove that our safety efforts are working

V. <u>Business of the Day: Allocation Requests/Funding Requests</u>

- All Campus Transfer Association (ACTA)
 - Work with all transfer orgs across the campus, and has a seat on AS
 - Service to transfers
 - Get input from transfers
 - Solves issues
 - Transfer graduation will be a thing this year, and will happen through ACTA
 - o Board of 30 people including transfer college reps
 - o Dinner and a movie
 - Quarterly event that always sells out

- \$5 for a dinner and a movie
 - Unit price is \$27, so \$5 helps a lot
- Targeting between 100-150 people
- Sold all 120 tickets last year
- Will open 100 tickets, and if those sell super fast then we'll open
 50 more
- 7 different options for burgers including vegan, vegetarian, chicken, beef, and turkey burgers
- o \$14.85 for the movie ticket, and \$12.50 for Red Robin meal
- Move to allocate \$300 from GU (General Unallocated) to ACTA for Dinner and a Movie. (Gus, Muir) 10-0-2
 - Move to suspend bylaw VIII-L (Gus, Uma) 12-1-2
- Mitchell Former MOB Head
 - Been working with Katy and Muir Writing to create an academic event called the Scholar Chatter Challenge
 - We're lacking in communication skills
 - Students can choose a topic they find interesting and find a primary source to back it up
