- MCC Budget Presentation
 - Budget is an estimation based on carry-over from last year and projected student enrollment
 - Must match our budget with Student Business Office
 - We're currently at a lower standing than we thought we were in regards to our budget
 - o Income:
 - Vending Machine Income (Council Initiative Fund)
 - Reserved for bigger council projects that affect the entire Muir community
 - Muir Activity Fee
 - Over \$100K per year
 - AS Backfunding + AS Activity Fee
 - Larger than normal because of AS Backfunding
 - o All of the funds technically come from the same place
 - Money that will come in the spring will help with our deficit and we'll have around 30k left
 - o BUDGET Based on 3800 people, but there are actually over 4000 students
 - better to underestimate students and budget than to overestimate
 - Really think about where your money is coming from before you just give away money / allocations during meeting
 - It's easy to give money away but we're representing the college's questions
 - Patty's been talking to SBO
 - believe that they've been incorrectly spending MCC money
 - Ex. charged council for Muir Musical event
 - Trying to make a plan to build up council funds
 - Want to make sure council gets their money back

- o Don't forget:
 - There are a lot of things happening in Spring Quarter that hasn't been taken out of the budget yet
 - Keep this in mind when allocating funds

V. <u>Business of the Day: Allocation Requests/Funding Requests</u>

- Food Waste Study Funding Request
 - o \$150 for the food waste study Sustainable Dinner
 - o Provost game some money that would go toward incentives
 - Three tiered education model
 - 1st week general education about sustainability with brochure
 - 2nd week would get brochure and education from Econauts
 - 3rd tier would have sustainable dinner
 - Want to see if interaction and constant information affect how effective it is
 - o Dinner for 20-22 people
 - To increase interaction
 - Would be an educational portion to the dinner
 - o Compost bins total around \$100
 - Will also ask for funding from SSC
 - o Need to buy scale, brochures, flyers, and paying for the dinner
