- Justin Director of Muir College Center
 - o Middle of Muir and Purveyor of Products (MOM and POP)
 - o El Portal
 - Used to have a pool table in
 - Means "The Hallway" in Spanish
 - MOM is self supporting
 - taken big steps to be sure it's affordable
 - All of the revenue goes back into sustaining MOM
 - O Why do students need MOM?
 - It means a lot to both current students and alumni
 - People feel comfortable to it, it's familiar
 - It's a product of the people that are in that space
 - Many of you have projects to complete and programs you want to do those could include collaboration with the College Center
 - o Uma: planned an event at MOM last quarter

 - Many words we want to be eliminated from the vernacular
 - Kickoff during week 2 of Spring quarter
 - o Also likely a Wednesday
 - o Expect to see it in the Quad or in MOM
- Week 3 Thurday, April 14
 - Linguistics Dept used to have a language heritage film series
 - Want to get into showing more movies at MOM
 - Will be showing a Bollywood film (heritage language: Hindi)
 - Will be doing a Spanish language film later in the quarter
- Ouestion: how often is inventory changed?
 - Fritos guy comes every other Tuesday
 - Baked Hot Cheetos came in a few weeks ago but the supplier said they didn't have them anymore
 - Things that don't sell well won't be put on the shelves
 - Trying to expand inventory to things you can't find elsewhere

 - Not a formal graduation ceremony, more of a celebration for graduation
 - Transfers are between 16 and 56 years old
 - Veterans
 - Parents with families
 - · Want to celebrate this diversity

 - will be sending a special video message to be shown at the Transfer Graduation
 - Will have an additional keynote speaker
 - Susan Berry may be the keynote speaker
 - lots of other proposals as well
 - Will also have student speakers
 - want to showcase uniqueness and diversity of transfers to share their story
 - June 4 12-3pm
 - Asking College Councils for \$500 each
 - Funds will likely go to catering
 - About \$3000 for catering alone
 - About \$9000 total
 - \$2000 from ACTA
 - \$800 from ACCB
 - Asking VCSA and Chancellor for funding as well
 - Intended to be a celebration of the community coming together
 - Will host 50 students, can bring family members, ~15 Muir students – around 200 people there total
 - Students required to RSVP (first come, first serve) contribute \$15 to ensure attendance
 - \$45 per stole, large part of cost
 - Suggestions: maybe change name to Transfer Graduation
 Celebration, change giveaway to something less expensive, not
 have family members go, try and utilize funds to have more
 students there, look into alumni funding, maybe sell stoles instead
 of giving them away
 - Potential funding from Triton Community Fund and SPACES

 - Winter Quarter event recap
 - Social in Half Dome, ~15 people attended
 - Pizza Social, ~25 people attended
 - Camaraderie among students was good to see
 - Rock Climbing, ~5 people attended
 - Conflict with Bear Garden probably affected turn out
 - o Asking for \$850 for:
 - Pizza Social in Spring Quarter
 - 30 people expected
 - \$200 for pizza, salad (ran out last time)
 - 8 pizzas, 1 large salad, 24 garlic twists (\$177+tax+tip)
 - Hiking at Potato Chip
 - 15 people expected
 - \$35 for 24 bagels/cream cheese
 - M3C collaborations
 - BOOMERS \$7 subsidy, 15 people max; \$105 total
 - Movie night at PC Theater, \$200 for candy
 - Bonfire at end of quarter at La Jolla Shores
 - 30 people expected
 - \$310 total for food, etc
 - o Plan to advertise through Facebook, social media, TMT email, flyering
 - o GBM's aren't planned for next quarter so far, weighing pros and cons
 - Not funding BOOMERS at the moment since details are still hazy
 - Move to allocate \$745 from General Unallocated to Tribe of Muir Transfers for Spring Quarter events. (Gus, Ricky) 3-5-2 – failed
 - Move to allocate \$750 from General Unallocated to Tribe of Muir Transfers for Spring Quarter events with the stipulation that they have GBM's during Spring Quarter for TMT continuation/outreach. (Gus, Ricky) 9-1-1

 - o MVP JMC Week Lien is for annual JMC Week event
 - Meant to connect Muir students with community service without having to make a commitment to MVP
 - In the past have gone to Stein's Family Farm, considering other options this year
 - \$430 is for transportation (bus) and snacks (event runs through lunch time)
