### X. New Council Business

- Bylaw Changes
  - o Section II A 8d, Environmental Advocate
    - MEC & MCC coordination for event
    - Move to approve bylaw change to II A 8d (Gus, Danny) 9-1-3
      - Objection (Lesly): don't think they should have to do another project
        - Intention is for their project to be a collaboration, bylaw change is meant to clarify that they are meant to work with MEC and not just MCC; not adding another project
      - Objection withdrawn
    - Concern: it may not be possible for Environmental Advocate to work with SSC. They do separate projects, and their meetings aren't open. Recommending rewording.
    - Motion failed, didn't meet 2/3 affirmative vote of entire Council
  - Patty: suggestion to do open roll call vote online and do discussions tonight
  - o Move to extend time by 72 hours move by consensus
  - o Bylaw II A 8d: Environmental Advocate
    - Might limit creativity of planning/creating project
      - Working with 2 groups could limit ideas approved
    - Shouldn't be a forced collaborative/coordinating event
      - o People should have freedom in planning
    - This change doesn't mean they have to work completely with both organizations, just communicating/coordinating so that everyone is in the loop
    - May want to make this change so that in the future people aren't confused on what is expected of them
    - This position deals with the exec board of other organization, has to be something that entire board plus adviser are okay with
      - Limitation pleasing everyone
    - Hasn't been discussed with MEC
  - o Bylaw II A 11c: Commuter Rep
    - Is a good idea because commuters are the ones using the lockers, will help Commuter Rep be involved with commuter population
    - Reason putting it in is because the Commuter Rep from 2 years ago (Ismael) is still doing this job
      - Want to pass down duties for the future
  - Bylaw II A 12c: Resident Rep
    - Same comments as Bylaw II A 8d: Environmental Advocate

- Being on the MRC Exec Board and a liaison between MRC and MCC is a lot of work in itself
- The exec board will also be affected by this bylaw change, since they work on events/projects as a group
- Bylaw II B 8d: Spirit Chair
  - Should stay as is because it is an external position
  - This position is only about doing 1 project, they should want to do something on their own, we don't have to make it a requirement
  - After Spirit Night their job is essentially done the way wording is now, they might as well resign
  - Council was in favor of this last week (10-7?)
  - Adding this will let people know they are expected to do more than just Spirit Night
  - This change was talked about with old Spirit Night Committee Chair (Moiz)
  - This is a good change because there won't be any confusion when applying of what is expected from people
  - Council may want to consider that we don't require much work from external positions
    - This change could set a precedent for more activity from external members
    - Encouraging both internal and external members to do work in Council
  - Triton Athletic Council (TAC)
    - o Hold more than 35 events a quarter
    - Athletes are required to go to these events, other students don't attend them
    - The Spirit Chair could talk to athletes about TAC to get more general student involvement
    - One of these events could then be turned into a spirit event
  - Straw poll. Gus
    - o Option 1: want this change 9
    - o Option 2: don't want this change 8
  - Straw poll, Waz
    - o Option 1: want this change 5
    - o Optioj 2: don't want this change 5
    - Option 3: want adding TAC to bylaws as option for spirit event/making Spirit Chair aware of TAC as a possible collaboration group – 14
  - Move to have an open roll call vote for Bylaw changes (Kylie, Waz) 11-0-3
  - o Go to rules committee to give your input and feedback on these changes!
